Teleworks USA, KellyConnect Set to Hold Hiring Events April 30-May 2 in Annville, Harlan, and Hazard

Jobseekers across the region will have the opportunity to prepare and apply for open teleworking positions with global telework company KellyConnect during three days of hiring events from April 30 through May 2. Prospective teleworkers will also have a chance to greatly increase their potential to be hired by KellyConnect by participating in free Teleworks USA Tech Prep Workshops in advance of the hiring events.

Teleworks USA and KellyConnect are partnering to host the hiring events on:

All events will be held from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on their respective dates.

KellyConnect is seeking to hire Inbound Technical Support Representatives, and will have company representatives on hand to interview candidates in person for work-from-home positions that can be performed via a computer and broadband connection.

Individuals who feel they already have a proven, working knowledge of macOS and iOS are welcome to apply at the hiring events, but should first contact their nearest Teleworks Hub between now and April 23 to determine whether workshop attendance may still be necessary to increase hiring potential.
